young leaders and students from across Europe.

**Objectives:** 

o To provide participants with a realistic simulation of EU legislative procedures.

To enhance participants' understanding of European politics and policy-making.

To foster cross-cultural dialogue and collaboration among European youth.

## • Key Activities:
